3 reasons why you need to fix your dentures in place

- 1. Wearing dentures can be embarrassing. Sometimes they fall out or come loose. And you worry about it happening in public.
- 2. Eating, talking and even smiling can be a problem too. When was the last time you ate a steak, apple or corn on the cob?
- 3. Without teeth or implants, the jawbone shrinks away. This can give you sunken cheeks making you look older.

What is a Dental Implant?

A Dental Implant is made up of 3 parts:

- 1. The implant itself, a small titanium screw which is placed into the jaw bone to act like the root of a tooth
- 2. The crown, bridge or denture, this is the visible part of the implant which forms your new teeth
- 3. The abutment, this is the part which joins the root and the crown together.

The process:

Your dentist will place titanium implants under your gums. Typically, the area is then left to heal to allow the jaw and implants time to integrate. However, in some cases it is possible to place immediate temporary bridges onto the implants giving you new teeth in just one session!

If you are missing many, or all of your teeth, there are several ways that implants can be used to replace them:

1. A "clip in" denture - two implants are placed in the jaw which clip on to your acrylic denture holding it in place. This type of denture is removable and is only suitable for replacing lower teeth.



2. Implant Retained Bridges - depending on how many teeth you are missing, varying number of implants can be used to support fixed bridges. Two implants can be used to support 3 teeth, if you require a full arch replacement this can be carried out with 6-8 implants.



3. All-on-4 – four implants can be used to secure an entire arch of new teeth, this method has many advantages over the other options.





Comfortable and secure

So now you can have the natural look and feel of modern ceramic or acrylic dentures. But there's no fear – there will be no more sore spots or ulcers from moving dentures, they're not going anywhere.

Implants can be used to secure upper dentures, lower dentures or both.
